



## Pre-Congress Workshops-1st July, 2021

1. **Comprehensive Colposcopy and LLETZ Workshop** will cover the basics of colposcopy and treatment of CIN with lectures by eminent experts in the field.
2. **Cytopathology & HPV Workshop** is aimed at pathologists, cytologists and clinicians who wish to update themselves on the basics of diagnostic techniques.
3. **Surgical options for CIN and Cervical Cancer** will showcase all surgical procedures for the treatment of CIN and early cervical cancer. Delegates will have the opportunity to learn live anatomy and understand the basic concepts of these procedures from experts in the field.
4. **Training the Trainer Workshop** is for practicing colposcopists who wish to get trained as trainer for IFCPC distance learning program in colposcopy. Lectures and discussion will focus on the structure of program, understanding the needs of trainee, how to train, mentor a trainee and prepare them for the exit exam.

## Post-Conference Workshops-5th July, 2021

1. **Vulvar Reconstructive Surgery Workshop** is designed to enhance skills on surgical techniques needed to perform a variety of vulvar reconstructive surgical procedure including laying out excisions and closure techniques, corner sutures and dog-ear revision, flap and grafts including O-to-Z plasty V-Y and double V-Y plasty, rotation, and A-T flap.
2. **Vulva workshop** is a comprehensive module on vulvar disorders by eminent national and international experts will make one well-versed with diagnosis and management of common vulvo-vaginal conditions.
3. **Screen n' Treat Workshop** (In association with Jhpiego) aims to provide knowledge of screening by Visual Inspection with Acetic acid (VIA), its technique and interpretation; basis and methods of treatment by ablation.
